Every year we celebrate Gurupurnima, the most important spiritual festival of the year. This year, according to the ancient Indian astrological calendar - Jyotish - Gurupurnima falls on the full moon day of Ashadh (June - July) and is celebrated in memory of the great Rishi Ved Vyasa on July 24, 2021. On this day we surrender all our spiritual practices from the past year at Gurudev's lotus feet.

According to the teachings of God Shiva, Sri Alakpuriji and Adi Guru Shankaracharya, on this day of holy Gurupurnima, all spiritual masters, Mahamandaleshwars should be worshipped by the spiritual seekers and disciples by performing Guru Puja. They should offer them clothes, food and donations, adorn them with tilak and flower mala, and bathe Guru's holy feet in water and milk.

At the same time, it is the duty of all Mahamandaleshwars and Sannyasis to guide all bhaktas, students, practitioners and disciples and to support them on their spiritual path towards harmony, tolerance and peace and lead them to Brahman. Yoga in Daily life is not only physical exercise, but it is the system that brings us to our higher self and promotes respect, equality and harmony among all religions and spiritual seekers of different paths.

Gurupurnima Satsangs should be held in all our ashrams and yoga centers. Those who cannot attend should celebrate them anywhere in the world in their homes. The image of Gadi Patti must always be present at pujas at home, ashrams or temples.
